- Control ray tracing accuracy and precision based on the requirements of your system and stage of your design using LightTools' state-of-the-art ray tracing




Figure 1: LED street lamp modeled in LightTools, including illuminance analysis results and photorealistic rendering of lit appearance

- Interactively adjust system parameters and, with a single click, quickly assess the impact on your performance criteria




Figure 2: LED street lighting illuminance and intensity displayed in the 3D Design view

#### Street Lighting Utility

- Includes visualization tools that display illuminance, intensity and mesh data directly in the LightTools 3D Design view




Figure 3: The Street Lighting Utility provides options to help you visualize illuminance patterns on the street in relation to lamp post geometry
